

DECLARATION CONCERNED WITH THE CONFORMITY TO EU-DIRECTIVES

Heerhugowaard (NL), 03 November 2005.

This declaration is concerned with meeting the requirements given in legislation based on:

1. the EU-Directive 2002/96/EC: on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE directive);
2. the EU-Directive 2002/95/EC: on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS-directive);
3. European Regulation EC No.1935/2004: on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. has joined (national) organisations that take care of the collection, treatment and useful reuse or recycling of the waste of electrical and electronic equipment in a manner approved by the government. These organisations will care for the collection, treatment, storing and transport of the waste of the electrical and electronic equipment on behalf of

BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V..

Since 01 August 2005 BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. also attaches the required mark on the electrical and electronic equipment she produces and sells within the European Community.

By joining the said organisations and attaching the required information and marks on the electrical and electronic equipment she produces and sells, BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. meets the legal requirements based on the EU-directive 2002/96/EC.

BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. requires all the suppliers of components, parts, and materials to supply her only with products that do not contain any:

- Lead (Pb);
 - Mercury (Hg);
 - Cadmium (Cd);
 - hexavalent Chromium (Cr₆₊);
 - Polybrominebiphenyls (PBBs); or
 - Polybrominediphenylethers (PBDEs),
- from February 2006 onward.

With this requirement to her suppliers, together with additional checks on compliance, BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. plans to meet the requirements given in the EU-directive 2002/95/EC on 01 July 2006, as far as the state of the arts and technology will allow.

BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. has taken steps to come to a system which should enable her to trace and follow a material or article through all stages of manufacture, processing and distribution (traceability). With this system in place BRAVILOR BONAMAT B.V. plans to be able to meet the requirements given in EU-Regulation No. 1935/2004, which comes into force on 01 October 2006.
